








# **Last train to Tokyo**





## History of "Nikko Waraku Odori"

"Nikko Waraku Odori" (folk dance) has started in 1913 to commemorate the visit of their Majesties: the Taisho Emperor and Empress to the Nikko Copper Refinery, which was known as the predecessor of the present Nikko Works of Furukawa Electric Co., Ltd.

It was the very first time that the Emperor visited a private plant. "Nikko Waraku Odori" started at the celebration after the visit. The plant workers were filled with so much emotion that they started dancing spontaneously after carrying out such an important mission of welcoming their Majesties.
